Administration Update: Katie Sodaro- Jensen – 20 min

Budget, Including growth and decline of enrollment

This is the first year the budget feels good. Discertionary funds are for teachers and non-discretionary funding is for ELL, Gifted and Special Education. District Projection was 340 and Katie requested it be changed to 295. This year we had 13 additional students.

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TBE will add a 1.0 School Psychologist. (Currently .2)

School Counselor, SW and Psychologist will all be full time.

Sped will stay the same

ELD will remain .5 (Multilingual learners)

Gifted and Talented will be a 1.0 (Currently .5)

TBE will have two classes per grade level

PE, Music, Art, Library and Health will be at .5

All classified positions will remain for next school year.

There is a new formula for Weighted Student Funding based on several factors (Academic Intervention, Small School Factor, Students receiving special education services, Gifted and Talented)

Currently there is \$65,000 Supplies (Curriculum, \$66,717 will be the carry over) There is \$7000 allocated to the Budget Leadership Team

Superintendent Message regarding growth and decline: There is a discussion about repurposing schools. There is a discussion about combining schools. TBE is a school for all students as well as an overflow for Coyote Creek Elementary. DCSD's goal is to inform people of the "why" and discuss potential long term plans.

Every month TBE has a firedrill, The lockdown drills and Shelter in Place drills are completed every other month. It is good to practice the drills. TBE is getting six new walkie talkie. There will be an additional walkie talkie in case someone from the district comes. PTO is offering to purchase additional walkies.

There was a discussion surrounding the evacuation at TBE last week.
